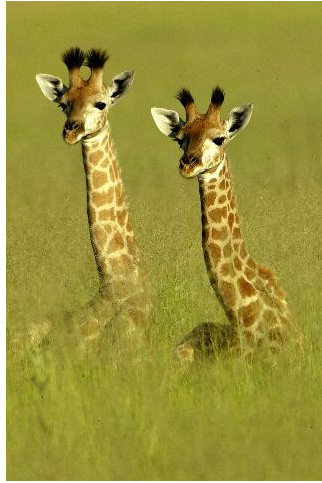

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Detailed Itinerary

DAYS 1 - 3 CAPE TOWN

Arrive Cape Town today and enjoy the next three incredible days and nights exploring the many wonders of the Cape.

You will be met and privately transferred to Four Rosmead Guest House. It is within walking distance of the city as well as vibrant Kloof Street, which is well known for its restaurant and café culture.

Overnight: Four Rosmead Guest House

DAYS 4 & 5 VICTORIA FALLS

You will transfer to the Cape Town Airport for your scheduled flight to Victoria Falls, via Johannesburg. Upon arrival in the falls, you will be met and escorted to the Zambezi Sun Hotel where you have two days to explore the falls.

The Zambezi Sun is a 3 star 212-room hotel.

Overnight: Zambezi Sun Hotel

DAYS 6 & 7 BOTSWANA SAFARI – CHOBE NATIONAL PARK

Transfer by road to Kasane Airport. From here, you will board your light aircraft flight to Chobe Savannah Lodge for two nights.

Situated in the Eastern Caprivi of Namibia, on a peninsula on the northern bank of the Chobe River. It is home to large herds of elephant, buffalo and hippo, as well as concentrations of other wildlife.

Chobe Savanna Lodge accommodates only 24 guests and is relaxed and informal, set in a classic African Savanna environment with sweeping vistas surrounding the lodge. Facilities include a swimming pool and an open boma area on the banks of the Chobe River.

Guests have a choice of boat excursions, fishing (catch & release), and cultural village visits to one of the surrounding local communities.

Overnight: Chobe Savanna Lodge

DAYS 8 & 9 BOTSWANA SAFARI – OKAVANGO DELTA

Transfer via light aircraft to Camp Okavango for two nights.

Camp Okavango is situated on the remote Nxaragha Island in the heart of the permanent Okavango Delta, assuring a year-round water wilderness experience.

Camp Okavango accommodates only 24 guests in intimate exclusivity in East African-style safari tents, individually situated on raised teak platforms with en-suite facilities and private viewing decks.

Game-viewing activities include exploring the Okavango by canoe (mokoro) and motorboat, guided nature walks, bird-watching, and fishing.

Overnight: Camp Okavango

DAYS 10 & 11
BOTSWANA SAFARI – MOREMI WILDLIFE RESERVE

You transfer by boat to Camp Moremi for two nights.

Camp Moremi is situated on the beautiful Xakanaxa Lagoon in the eastern extremity of the Okavango Delta and within the Moremi Wildlife Reserve.

This varied habitat attracts and supports a diversity of wildlife which is unrivaled in Botswana with possible sightings of wild dog, cheetah, leopard, lion, elephant and buffalo being highlights.

The Camp accommodates a maximum of 22 guests in beautifully furnished East African style safari tents with private adjacent bathroom facilities.

Activities include morning & afternoon game drives in open 4x4 safari vehicle, powerboat excursions, and bush walks.

Overnight: Camp Moremi

DAY 12

Transfer by light aircraft to Maun Airport to connect with your flight to Johannesburg and onto your international flight to the United States.
